Nose Pickers from Outer Space, by Gordon Korman/ K,W

Devin Hunter can't wait to meet his exchange buddy--and imagines one cool dude. But Stan breaks all the rules of coolness, including the particularly embarrassing habit of picking his nose. Strange things start happening, though, and Devin soon realizes that Stan may not even be human.
