- \* Stories that will appeal to as well as broaden your child's interest
- \* Stories that are funny, and can promote question asking and discussion with your child
- \* Stories based on traditional folk and fairy tales (Three Little Pigs; Cinderella, etc.) as well as realistic stories that could really happen
- \* Longer stories that state a problem, show different ways of looking at the problem, and resolve the problem in a creative way
- \* Stories that you will enjoy reading to your child with enthusiasm. Encourage your child to read the story to you, as well.
