- * Predictable books, where sentences repeat, words rhyme, and the pictures closely resemble what the text is saying.
- * Pictures that feature aspects of your toddler's life (i.e. making a mess, bedtime, playing with toys, etc.)
- * Books that can promote question asking and discussion with your toddler
- * Books that you will enjoy reading aloud to your toddler with enthusiasm!
